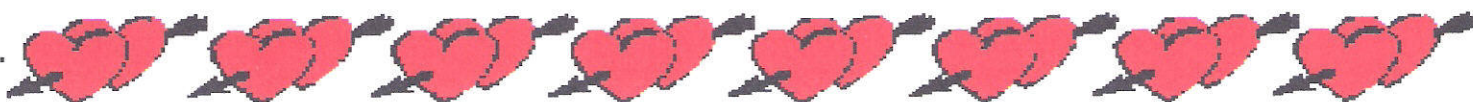
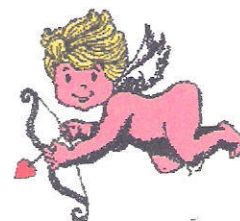

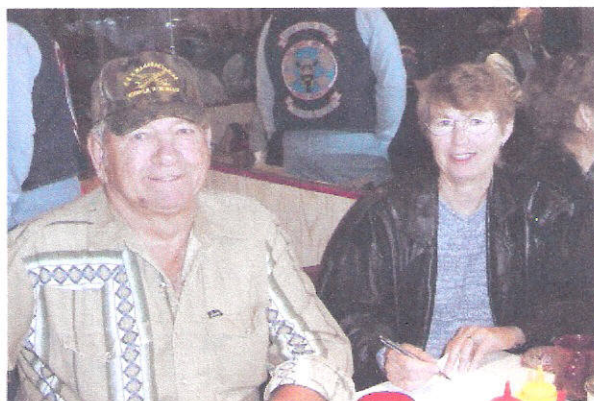

COMPANY POTATOES

3 medium potatoes cooked, cooled and grated or 1 to 2 lbs. frozen hash brown potatoes

sauce:

- 1 can cream of chicken soup
- 1/2 cup butter
- 1-1/2 cups grated cheddar cheese
- 1 pint sour cream
- 1/3 cup onions (diced)

method:

Heat soup and butter, add cheese, onions and sour cream. In a 9" X 13" cooking dish, add potatoes and sauce, spread until smooth and sprinkle with crushed corn flakes or potato chip crumbs. Bake at 350 degrees for 45 minutes.

CAN BE DONE ONE NIGHT AHEAD

FROZEN FRUIT SALAD

9" x 13" dish

- 1 large pkg. cream cheese (softened)
- 2/3 cup white sugar
- 2 large chopped bananas
- 1 small can mandarin oranges (drained)
- 1 15 oz. can crushed pineapple (drained)
- 1 9 oz. pkg. frozen strawberries or your choice of frozen berries (or 2 cups fresh chopped berries)
- 1 cup chopped nuts of your choice
- 1 10 oz. Kool Whip

Mix together cream cheese and sugar and gradually add the following ingredients in order given. Freeze thoroughly. Serve partially thawed.

(For a lighter dish, may use low fat cream cheese and low fat Kool Whip)
